Name of activity: ChristCare Group Leader

Mission Team responsible:

How much time is required, and how often? About one and a half hours at a meeting twice a month or every other week, plus about 30 minutes meeting preparation at home.

When (time of day/week/month) is this activity performed? Currently there are seven ChristCare groups. Some meet on week nights, one is on a week day afternoon, and one meets on a Saturday morning.

Please describe what this activity entails: A group leader is responsible for planning and facilitating each meeting or assigning part or all of the activities to one or more of the group members. The leader is responsible for covering all aspects of ChristCare which are Sharing, Biblical Equipping, Prayer & Worship, and Missional Service. The leader must also ensure that all information is kept confidential so that a high level of trust is developed and maintained within the group.

How much training is needed to perform this activity? When is it provided? Initial training involves several 2 to 3 hour sessions over approximately a 3 month period. Subsequent training occurs about twice a year on specific topics. The Equippers lead the training sessions.
