

Volunteer Activities Description

Name of activity: Stewardship Every Member Response (EMR) visitor/caller

Mission Team responsible: Stewardship

How much time is required, and how often? About 1 to 2 hours in a cottage meeting with members; 45 minutes to an hour at a training meeting; and about 30 minutes to an hour making phone calls and preparing a brief report of the cottage meeting and responses from your phone calls.

When (time of day/week/month) is this activity performed? Training is on a Sunday morning after a worship service usually in September or October. Cottage meetings and phone calls are made from late September through October.

Please describe what this activity entails: Attend a training meeting to become familiar with the contents of a prepared presentation (hard copy). Make phone calls to about 10 members on a list and invite them to attend a meeting at a member home or at church. Each visitor is assigned a partner to make the calls and lead a meeting at a member home. During some years, only a phone call is made to invite members to a meeting at church that is led by a member of the stewardship mission team.

How much training is needed to perform this activity? When is it provided? Training is provided by the stewardship mission team about 1 to 2 weeks prior to the stewardship fall program.

Where is this activity performed? Training at church; meetings at church and sometimes at member homes; phone calls are made from home
